Addition of Article 31 and item 3.11:

## "3¹. **Operators arrangement**

Operators concerned may agree to deviate from field strength level in item 3.1, 3.2 by mutual consent, concluding an arrangement between operators with the consent of the Parties concerned. Such operator arrangement shall only be valid as long as all participating operators hold exclusive rights of use of concerned frequencies.".
